
An Acetylcholine Modulator

Background: The Biochemical Mechanics of Normal Neuro-Transmission



- During normal neurotransmission, acetylcholine (ACh) is released from the presynaptic neuron into the synaptic space, and binds to the nicotinic ACh receptor (nAChR) on the postsynaptic neuron. Once ACh binds to a nerve's receptor, the receptor opens an ion channel, allowing Sodium (K+) and Potassium (Na+) ions to flow through the neuron's exterior membrane and across the synaptic space. This is how electrochemical nerve signals pass from one nerve cell to the next
- As soon as the channel is open and ions are flowing, the enzyme Acetylcholinesterase (AChE, located on the postsynaptic neuron) begins breaking down the ACh, causing the ion channel to close and the nerve signal to stop – like removing the ACh "key" from the receptor "lock"
 - The nerve absorbs and recycles the ACh components to synthesize new ACh, like LEGO bricks continuously coming together and being broken apart
- The whole process of binding, signaling, and breakdown occurs in a fraction of a second
 - Indeed, one AChE molecule can tear apart 25,000 ACh molecules per second


Plus relief: How it Works, continued

An Acetylcholine Modulator

Plus Relief binds to the same nicotinic nerve receptors (nAChR) normally used by the

neurotransmitter Acetylcholine (ACh)

- The protein peptides in Plus Relief (primarily α-Cobratoxin) bind to the same nACh receptors, with an affinity orders-of-magnitude greater than ACh. This blocks ACh from bonding, thus inhibiting ion flow and preventing neurotransmission
- Importantly, AChE cannot break down Cobratoxin, so the receptors remain blocked for much longer, and the nerve signals remain impeded for a longer time – like breaking off a chemical "key" in the receptor "lock" *
 - At full concentration (i.e. snake bite), this would cause muscular paralysis and eventual death (when the toxins paralyze the diaphragm)
- At Plus Relief's greatly diluted concentration, the result is a Neuro-Modulatory Effect – "turning down the volume" of pain signals, and preventing the resulting inflammatory cascade reaction
 - Typical dose is 30-140μg/ml
 - Compared to typical Botox dose of 0.33ng/ml: Plus Relief is up to 480,000x more concentrated
- * Interesting side note: while cobratoxins reversibly bind to nAChR, Organophosphate Pesticides (and the military nerve agents derived from them) bind irreversibly/ permanently, causing paralysis, seizure, and death much faster than a snake bite.

 Plus Relief is currently classified as a
 Homeopathic:
 - Highly diluted active ingredients; all natural ingredients;
 venom already in the Homeopathic Pharmacopeia
 - Is manufactured using current Good Manufacturing Practices (cGMP), incl. testing all raw materials and finished batches, and obtaining Certificates of Analysis on all batches
